



## Selectmen's Meeting Summary February 11, 2013 – 1 PM

Chairman Ross-Raymond called meeting to order at 1 PM. This meeting is for discussion of finalizing budget figures before tonight's budget public hearing.

Doug Greiner came in to pick up signed CPG application. Selectmen confirmed that the \$21,500 is in the proposed budget. Noting that \$1000 for round 1 and \$335 for round 2 is the total out of pocket cost to town. Other is offset by grant and will show on revenue side as income.

Selectmen also confirmed that the Recycling budget has been increased by \$1150 for a total of \$6050 to more accurately cover projected costs.

Police Proposed Budget: After reviewing the letter concerning possible charges for detail work by Webster if they are dispatched to Salisbury, and discussions with Merrimack County Sheriff and others, Selectmen feel it is appropriate to leave the figure of \$12,500. They will be following up with Merrimack County Dispatch and Webster Police re: how many calls for Salisbury were dispatched and covered by Webster for 2012.

### **Revisit Pistol Permit Process:**

After additional discussion regarding the charging for background checks by Sheriff's dept. and realizing by going with the law enforcement agency to actually issue the permit – Selectmen unanimously agreed to have the process done by Merrimack County Sheriff Department. Permits will be returned to Selectmen Office for pick up by applicant.

**Other:** All business that shall legally come before the Board  
**Selectwoman Sheldon made a motion to adjourn at 1:47 PM; Selectman Ballou seconded. All voted in favor.**
